FELDSPAR AND SALT PRODUCTION IN CANADA - JULY, 1935.

FELDSPAR - Shipments of feldspar by Canadian producers were recorded at 2,371 tons in July, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. In June, 1,700 tons were shipped while in July, 1934, shipments amounted to 1,426 tons. A decrease of 8.3 per cent was shown in the shipments during the first seven months of 1935 as compared with 1934; the quantities were 7,650 tons and 8,341 tons, respectively.

Imports of ground feldspar into Canada in July rose to 96 tons worth \$1,780 from the June total of 3 tons at \$65. Receipts during the seven months ending July totalled 314 tons appraised at \$5,268.



SAIT - Commercial salt production in Canada during July amounted to 23,728 tons as against 16,432 tons in June and 16,724 tons in July, 1934. During the seven months ending July, 120,098 tons were produced; this was an advance of 11.1 per cent above the tonnage produced in the corresponding period of 1934.

Canadian salt exported in July reached a total of 1,092 tons as compared with 497 tons exported in the preceding month.

Imports of salt into Canada in July rose to 19,703 tons worth \$65,786 from the June total of 11,724 tons at \$46,771. The July importations were obtained from the following countries: Italy, 41.6 per cent; Russia, 18.2 per cent; the United States, 13.4 per cent; British West Indies, 10.6 per cent; Great Britain, 10.3 per cent; Spain, 4.9 per cent; and Newfoundland, and Germany the remainder. The month's receipts included 1 ton of table salt, 13,264 tons of salt for the use of sea or gulf fisheries, 3,916 tons of salt in bulk, n.o.p., and 2,522 tons of other salt in bags, barrels and other coverings.
