## MONTHLY REPORT

## FELDSPAR AND SALT PRODUCTION IN CANADA - MARCH, 1936.

FELDSPAR - Canadian producers reported shipments of feldspar amounting to 878 tons in March; during the preceding month 937 tons were shipped while in March, a year ago, 778 tons were shipped, according to a report issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the first quarter of 1936 shipments totalled 2,716 tons as compared with 2,074 tons in the corresponding period of 1935.

Ground feldspar importations in March declined to 5 tons worth \$123 from the February total of 102 tons at \$1,923.

SALT - Shipments of commercial salt by Canadian producers in March advanced to 13,411 tons from the total of 11,662 tons in the preceding month. The March, 1935, shipments were recorded at 13,794 tons.

Exports of salt from Canada in March amounted to 879 tons; in February 660 tons were exported.

Imports of salt into Canada in March totalled 7,899 tons valued at \$25,767 as compared with 2,888 tons worth \$13,312 imported in February. The United States supplied 44.4 per cent of the March importations; the British West Indies, 40.4 per cent; Spain, 14.3 per cent, and Great Britain, the remainder. The month's imports were made up of 1 ton of table salt, 3,654 tons of salt for sea or gulf fisheries, 4,029 tons of salt in bulk, n.o.p., and 215 tons of other salt, in bags, barrels and other coverings.
