MONTHLY REPORT

FELDSPAR AND SALT PRODUCTION IN CANADA - JULY, 1936.

FELDSPAR - Canadian producers reported shipments of feldspar amounting to 2,859 tons in July; during the preceding month 2,565 tons were shipped while in July, 1935, the total was 2,660 tons, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Shipments during the first seven months of 1936 totalled 10,194 tons as compared with 8,582 tons shipped in the corresponding period of 1935.

Imports of ground feldspar into Canada in July were recorded at 87 tons worth \$1,832; in June, 94 tons at \$1,834 were imported. Importations during the seven months ending July, 1936, amounted to 393 tons valued at \$7,738.

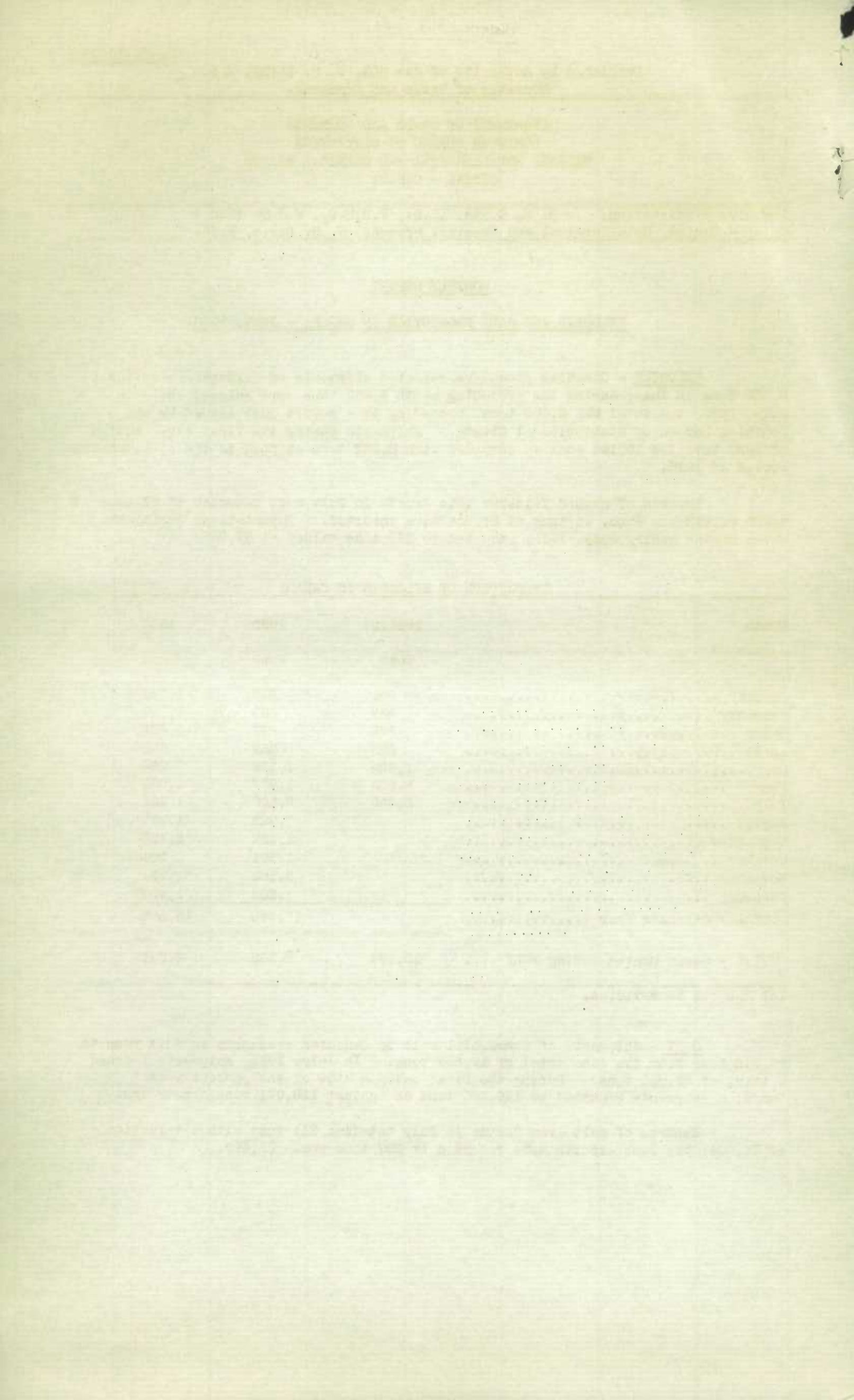

SALT - Shipments of commercial salt by Canadian producers in July rose to 20,962 tons from the June total of 19,257 tons. In July, 1935, shipments reached a total of 23,841 tons. During the first seven months of the current year Canadian shipments amounted to 119,385 tons as against 120,671 tons a year ago.

Exports of salt from Canada in July totalled 214 tons with a valuation of \$4,004; the June exports were recorded at 297 tons worth \$3,499.



Canada imported 10,266 tons of salt appraised at \$46,275 in July as compared with 12,589 tons at \$46,947 imported in June. The July importations were made up of 3,246 tons of salt for sea or gulf fisheries, 3,002 tons of salt in bulk, n.o.p., and 4,018 tons of other salt in bags, barrels, and other coverings. Great Britain supplied 38.8 per cent of the July imports; the United States, 30.8 per cent; British West Indies, 19.0 per cent; Spain, 8.1 per cent, and Newfoundland, 3.3 per cent.
