## MONTHLY REPORT

## FELDSPAR AND SALT PRODUCTION IN CANADA - AUGUST, 1936.

FELDSPAR - Shipments of feldspar by Canadian producers during August amounted to 1,910 tons as compared with 2,859 tons shipped in July and 1,923 tons shipped in August, 1935, according to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the eight months ending August, 12,104 tons of feldspar were shipped; in the corresponding period of the previous year shipments totalled 10,505 tons.

Ground feldspar importations in August consisted of 44 tons worth \$879 as against 87 tons at \$1,832 imported in July. Receipts during the period January to August, 1936, totalled 437 tons appraised at \$8,617.

SALT - Commercial salt shipments by Canadian producers amounted to 19,726 tons in August as compared with 20,962 tons in July and 15,786 tons in August, 1935. The Canadian shipments during the first eight months of 1936 totalled 139,111 tons or 1.9 per cent above the tonnage shipped a year ago.

Custom's records show that Canada exported 336 tons of salt in August; during the preceding month 214 tons were exported.

Imports of salt into Canada in August rose to 13,687 tons worth \$58,299 from the July total of 10,266 tons at \$46,275. The August importations consisted of 4 tons of table salt, 6,168 tons of salt for sea or gulf fisheries, 3,846 tons of salt in bulk, n.o.p., and 3,669 tons of other salt in bags, barrels, and other coverings. The United States accounted for 31.1 per cent of the August imports, Great Britain, 25.3 per cent, Spain, 21.9 per cent, British West Indies, 18.3 per cent, Newfoundland, 3.2 per cent, and Germany, the remainder.
