## MONTHLY REPORT

## FELDSPAR AND SALT PRODUCTION IN CANADA - JANUARY, 1937.

FEIDSPAR - The estimated shipments of feldspar in Canada in January were recorded at 1,177 tons in a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During Docember 1,500 tons were shipped while in January, 1936, shipments amounted to 901 tons.

Imports of ground feldspar into Canada in January reached a total of 141 tons appraised at \$2,638; in December, 50 tons worth \$773 were imported. Receipts during January, 1936, totalled 45 tons worth \$903.

SALT - Canadian producers reported shipments of commercial salt amounting to 11,910 tons in January as compared with 14,305 tons shipped in the preceding month and 11,013 tons in January, 1936.

Canada exported 215 tons of salt in January; during the preceding month 592 tons were exported.

Imports of salt into Canada in January declined to 4,203 tons appraised at \$12,290 from the December total of 4,347 tons worth \$14,482. The following countries were the sources of the January importations: the United States, 36.3 per cent; British West Indies, 32.1 per cent; Italy, 26.6 per cent and Great Britain, 5.0 per cent. Approximately 4 tons of table salt were imported in January, 1,288 tons of salt for sea or gulf fisheries, 2,702 tons of salt in bulk, n. o. p., and 209 tons of other salt in bags, barrels and other coverings.
