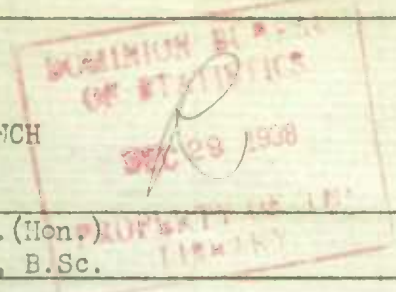

MONTHLY REPORT

FELDSPAR and SALT PRODUCTION IN CANADA - OCTOBER, 1938.

FELDSPAR - Shipments of feldspar by Canadian producers in October amounted to 1,217 tons, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. In September, 1,477 tons were shipped while in October, 1937, shipments totalled 1,693 tons. During the first ten months of 1938 Canadian shipments were recorded at 10,672 tons compared with 17,802 tons a year ago.

Receipts of ground feldspar during October rose to 46 tons worth \$754 from the September total of 6 tons at \$157.

SALT - Commercial salt shipments by Canadian producers in October totalled 33,169 tons; in September, 25,939 tons were shipped while in October, 1937, shipments amounted to 27,475 tons. During the first ten months of the current year, 221,214 tons were shipped or 6.4 per cent above the tonnage shipped in the corresponding period of 1937.

Exports of salt from Canada in October declined to 1,093 tons from the preceding month's total of 1,118 tons. During the calendar year to date, 9,842 tons were exported compared with 7,599 tons a year ago.

Importations of salt into Canada in October rose to 10,503 tons appraised at \$51,794 from the September receipts of 6,807 tons at \$38,660. The October imports consisted of 2,555 tons worth \$9,305 of salt for sea or gulf fisheries, 5,830 tons at \$15,007 of salt in bulk, n.o.p., and 4,068 tons at \$27,482 of salt in bags, barrels or other coverings. These imports were obtained from the following countries - The United States, 52.5 per cent; Great Britain, 38.6 per cent, and the British West Indies, 8.9 per cent.
