MONTHLY REPORT

FELDSPAR and SALT PRODUCTION IN CANADA - JUNE, 1938.

FELDSPAR - Shipments of feldspar during June amounted to 1,008 tons, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. In May, 1,128 tons were shipped while in June, 1937, shipments were higher at 1,801 tons.

Four tons of ground feldspar valued at \$114 were imported into Canada in June; during the preceding month, 6 tons at \$136 were imported.

SALT - Commercial salt shipments by Canadian producers rose to 28,515 tons in June from the May total of 25,662 tons and the June, 1937, total of 24,841 tons. During the first six months of the current year shipments totalled 119,026 tons or 5.9 per cent above the tonnage shipped a year ago.

Exports of salt from Canada in June declined to 932 tons; in May, 1,580 tons were exported.

An increase of 6.9 per cent was recorded in the imports of salt into Canada in June compared with the preceding month's importations; the totals were, 13,535 tons and 12,658 tons, respectively. The June receipts included 9 tons of table salt worth \$259; 8,437 tons of salt for sea or gulf fisheries at \$24,316; 3,055 tons of salt in bulk, n.o.p., at \$11,282, and 2,034 tons of salt in bags, barrels or other coverings at \$15,164. The British West Indies supplied 29 per cent of the June imports; the United States, 24 per cent; Italy, 18 per cent; Spain, 15 per cent, and Great Britain, 14 per cent.
