## MONTHLY REPORT

## FELDSPAR and SALT PRODUCTION IN CANADA - JULY, 1938.

FELDSPAR - Canadian producers shipped 886 tons of feldspar in July compared with 1,008 tons in the preceding month and 2,498 tons in July, 1937, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Shipments during the seven months ending July totalled 6,472 tons; a year ago, 11,742 tons were shipped.

Ground feldspar importations rose to 49 tons worth \$810 from the previous month's total of 4 tons at \$114.



SALT - Shipments of commercial salt by Canadian producers in July were recorded at 20,350 tons; in June, 28,515 tons were shipped while in July, 1937, shipments amounted to 23,317 tons. During the period January to July, 139,376 tons of commercial salt were shipped compared with 134,902 tons a year ago.

An increase of 29.8 per cent was shown in the exports of salt in July when 1,210 tons were shipped from Canada as against 932 tons in June.

Imports of salt into Canada in July amounted to 13,687 tons worth \*48,322; in the preceding month, 13,535 tons at \$51,021 were imported. The British West Indies supplied 33.4 per cent of the July imports; Italy, 21.7 per cent; Great Britain, 20.3 per cent; the United States, 10.4 per cent, and French Africa, Newfoundland and Germany, the remainder. The July receipts included 8,040 tons of salt for sea or gulf fisheries, 3,052 tons of salt in bulk, n.o.p., and 2,595 tons of salt in bags, barrels, or other coverings.
