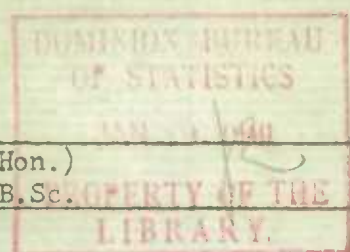

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MONTHLY REPORT

FELDSPAR and SALT PRODUCTION IN CANADA - OCTOBER, 1939

FELDSPAR - The Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa reports that the Canadian shipments of feldspar in October amounted to 1,535 tons; in September, 1,221 tons were shipped while in October, 1938 shipments totalled 1,344 tons. During the first ten months of 1939, Canadian producers shipped 8,988 tons compared with 11,782 tons a year ago.

Exports of feldspar advanced to 838 tons in October from the September total of 778 tons. Nepheline-syenite exports were recorded at 2,794 tons compared with 2,520 tons in September.

Imports of ground feldspar amounted to 60 tons valued at \$1,189 as against 103 tons at \$1,874 imported in September. Receipts during the period January to October aggregated 547 tons worth \$9,194.

SALT - Canadian producers shipped 33,278 tons of commercial salt in October compared with 26,322 tons in the preceding month and 33,169 tons in October, 1938. During the first ten months of 1939, shipments aggregated 209,835 tons; this represented a 5.1 per cent decrease from the quantity shipped a year ago.

Customs' records show that Canada exported 629 tons of salt in October; during the previous month, 819 tons were exported.

Imports of salt into Canada in October declined to 12,697 tons, made up of 2,930 tons of salt for sea or gulf fisheries worth \$10,663; 6,440 tons of salt in bulk, n.o.p., at \$25,475 and 3,327 tons of salt in bags, barrels and other coverings with a valuation of \$26,092.
