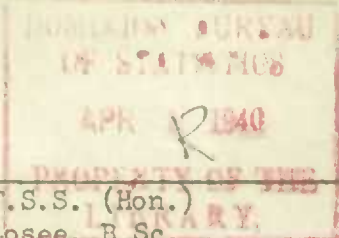

MONTHLY REPORT

FELDSPAR and SALT PRODUCTION IN CANADA - DECEMBER, 1939

FELDSPAR - Canadian producers shipped 2,017 tons of feldspar in December compared with 1,926 tons in the preceding month and 1,011 tons in December, 1938, according to a statement issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the calendar year, 12,931 tons were shipped; in the corresponding period of 1938, shipments totalled 14,058 tons.

Exports of feldspar from Canada in 1939 were recorded at 7,661 tons; a year ago, 8,232 tons were exported. Exportations of nepheline-syenite totalled 24,701 tons as against 26,008 tons in 1938.

Ground feldspar imports in 1939 amounted to 607 tons worth \$10,379 compared with 615 tons at \$10,083 imported in the previous year. These importations were obtained from the United States.

SALT - Shipments of commercial salt by Canadian producers totalled 13,035 tons; in November, 30,612 tons were shipped and in December a year ago, 13,574 tons. Shipments during the calendar year amounted to 253,482 tons or 5.8 per cent below the total for 1938.

The Canadian exports in December were recorded at 553 tons; during the calendar year, 10,656 tons were exported.

Imports during the month totalled 4,353 tons valued at \$18,120, while during the year 117,628 tons at \$507,368 were imported. The 1939 importations consisted of 10 tons of table salt worth \$366; 54,646 tons of salt for sea or gulf fisheries with a valuation of \$97,598; 54,659 tons of salt in bulk, n.o.p. at \$193,233, and 28,313 tons of salt in bags, barrels and other coverings worth \$216,171.
