## MONTHLY REPORT

FELDSPAR and SAIT PRODUCTION IN CANADA - MAY, 1939.

FELDSPAR - Shipments of feldspar by Canadian producers amounted to 803 tons in May; during the preceding month, 609 tons were shipped while in May, 1938, shipments totalled 1,128 tons, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the first five months of the current year, 3,729 tons of feldepar were shipped compared with 4,578 tons a year ago.

Exports of feldspar from Canada in May rose to 406 tons from the April total of 245 tons. Nepheline-syenite exports were recorded at 2,190 tons or 33.5 per cent above the tonnage exported in the previous month.

Ground feldspar importations into Canada were slightly higher amounting to 52 tons at $\$ 896$ in May compared with 36 tons worth $\$ 244$ in April. Imports during the period January to May aggregated 229 tons appraised at $\$ 3,534$.

SAIT - Canadian producers shipped 25,732 tons of salt in May; in the previous month 18,818 tons were shipped. Shipments during the five months ending May totalled 78,949 tons compared with 90,511 tons a year ago.

Salt exports from Canada in May amounted to 78 ? tons; the United States received 63.3 per cent of this quantity and New Zealand, 18.2 per cent. During the first five months of 1838 exports aggregated 4,005 tons.

Imports of selt into Canade in May were 104.8 per cent higher than in the preceding month; the totals were 10,356 tons at $\$ 43,807$ and 5,054 tons at $\$ 16,638$, respectively. The May importations included 2,971 tons of salt for sea or gulf fisheries; 4,810 tons of salt in bulk, n.0.p., and 2,575 tons of salt in bags, barrels and other coverings. Forty-eight per cent of the May receipts were obtained from the United States, 28 per cent from the British West Indies, and 24 per cent from Great Britain.
