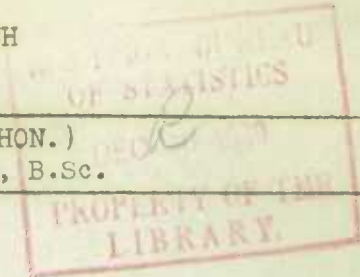

MONTHLY REPORT

FELDSPAR and SALT PRODUCTION IN CANADA - SEPTEMBER, 1939.

FELDSPAR - Shipments of feldspar by Canadian producers amounted to 1,221 tons in September compared with 614 tons in August and, 1,631 tons in September, 1938, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the first nine months of the current year, 7,453 tons were shipped; a year ago, shipments totalled 10,438 tons.

Custom's records show that Canada exported 776 tons of feldspar in September; in the preceding month, 505 tons were exported while, during the calendar year to date, exports aggregated 4,547 tons. Exports of nepheline-syenite rose to 2,320 tons in September from the August total of 2,000 tons.

Receipts of ground feldspar advanced to 103 tons appraised at \$1,874; in August, 4 tons worth \$118 were imported. Imports during the period, January to September amounted to 487 tons with a valuation of \$8,005.

SALT - Commercial salt shipments in September rose to 26,322 tons from the previous month's total of 21,073 tons and the September, 1938 total of 25,939 tons. Shipments during the nine months ending September totalled 176,557 tons or 6.1 per cent below the tonnage shipped a year ago.

Exports of salt from Canada in September amounted to 819 tons as against 1,800 tons in the preceding month.

Imports of salt into Canada were recorded at 11,379 tons, made up of 5 tons of table salt at \$185; 3,581 tons of salt for sea or gulf fisheries worth \$18,417; 3,865 tons of salt in bulk, n.o.p. at \$13,696 and 3,928 tons of salt in bags, barrels and other coverings valued at \$29,116.
