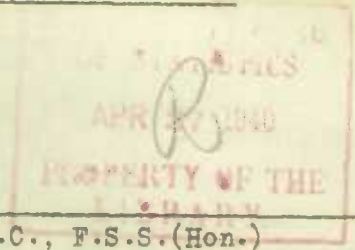

MONTHLY REPORT

FELDSPAR AND SALT PRODUCTION IN CANADA - JANUARY, 1940.

FELDSPAR - Shipments of feldspar by Canadian producers were recorded at 1,707 tons in January; in December 2,017 tons were shipped while in January, 1939 shipments totalled 762 tons, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa.

Exports of feldspar, from Canada in January amounted to 839 tons compared with 1,309 tons in the preceding month. Nepheline - syenite exportations were higher at 1,965 tons.

Ground feldspar importations were reported at 52 tons worth \$1,006 as against 52 tons at \$974 in the previous month.

SALT - Sales of commercial salt by Canadian producers totalled 12,493 tons in January; during the previous month, 13,035 tons were shipped while in January 1939 shipments were lower at 10,535 tons.

Canada exported 733 tons of salt in January compared with 553 tons in December. The United States received 49.5 per cent of the January exports.

The total imports of salt into Canada in January amounted to 6,111 tons appraised at \$22,743; the December total was 4,353 tons at \$18,120. The January receipts included 743 tons of salt for sea or gulf fisheries; 4,999 tons of salt in bulk, n.o.p. and 369 tons of salt, n.o.p. in bags, barrels and other coverings.
