MONTHLY REPORT

FELDSPAR AND SALT PRODUCTION IN CANADA - APRIL, 1940

FELDSFAR - Canadian producers reported shipments of feldspar in April totalling 467 tons compared with 1,159 tons in March and 609 tons in April, 1939, according to a statement just issued by the Dominion Eureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Shipments during the period January to April amounted to 6,571 tons; a year ago, 2,026 tons were shipped.

The Canadian exports of feldspar in April declined to 90 tons from the preceding month's total of 622 tons. Exportations of nepheline-syenite were recorded at 2,840 tons as against 3,202 tons in March.

Imports of ground feldspar into Canada in April were lower at 49 tons worth \$795; in March, 54 tons at \$972 were imported.

SALT - Commercial salt shipments by Canadian producers advanced to 20,900 tons in April from the March total of 13,319 tons and the April, 1939 total of 18,818 tons. Sales during the first four months of 1940 totalled 58,900 tons; this represented an increase of 8.6 per cent over the quantity sold a year ago.

Exports of salt from Canada in April rose to 474 tons; in March, 37 tons were exported. The United States received 43.7 per cent of the April exports.

Salt importations in April advanced to 9,362 tons worth \$31,582 as against 7,242 tons at \$25,854 imported in March. The April imports were made up of 200 tons of salt for the use of the sea or gulf fisheries worth \$1,438; 8,659 tons of salt in bulk, n.o.p. at \$25,362 and 523 tons of salt, n.o.p. in bags, barrels and other coverings with a value of \$4,782.
