

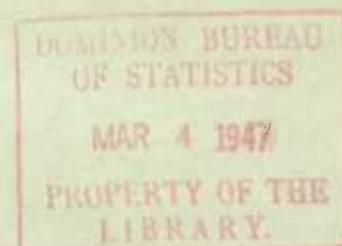

November, 1946



Production of salt or natural sodium chloride in Canada during November, 1946, totalled 54,994 short tons, including 38,763 tons of table, common fine and other commercial grades, and 16,231 tons for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for October, 1946, was 25,904 tons.

Shipments of commercial grades in November totalled 37,491 tons compared with 21,752 tons in October. Deliveries for chemical purposes totalled 16,001 tons in November compared with 5,706 tons in October.

Imports of salt, including all grades, totalled 32,401 tons valued at \$202,699 in November, and exports amounted to 36 tons valued at \$1,806.

Canadian salt production at the present time comes entirely from the provinces of Nova Scotia, Ontario, Manitoba and Alberta.

SALES

November, 1966

Production of sales of various kinds of goods in Canada during November, 1966, totaled 24,000 short tons, including 22,700 tons of fabric, 1,300 tons of other consumer goods, and 10,000 tons of other goods. The total output for November, 1966, was 23,700 tons.

Expenditure of commercial goods in November totaled 23,700 tons, valued at \$1,000,000. In October, however, the expenditure was 23,000 tons, valued at \$950,000.

Imports of goods, including all goods, totaled 23,700 tons, valued at \$1,000,000 in November, and exports amounted to 23,000 tons, valued at \$950,000.

On this date production of the goods was made entirely from the resources of two people, Canada, Ontario and Alberta.
