MONTHLY REPORT

S A L T

June, 1946.

Primary production of salt or natural sodium chloride in Canada during June, 1946, totalled 59,000 short tons, including 28,078 tons of table, common fine, and other commercial grades, and 30,922 tons for the manufacture of chemicals. The corresponding total output in May of this year was 60,118 tons.

Shipments of commercial grades in June totalled 28,647 tons compared with 31,541 tons in May. Deliveries for chemical purposes totalled 31,097 tons in June compared with 31,599 tons in May.

Imports of salt, including all grades, totalled 12,348 tons at \$88,366 in June and exports amounted to 714 tons valued at \$9,755.

Canadian salt production at the present time comes entirely from the provinces of Nova Scotia, Ontario, Manitoba and Alberta.
