

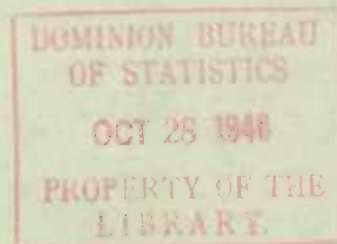

Production of salt or natural sodium chloride in Canada during August, 1946, totalled 15,625 short tons, including 15,107 tons of table, common fine and other commercial grades, and 518 tons for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for July, 1946 was 28,701 tons.

Shipments of commercial grades in August totalled 16,558 tons compared with 21,438 tons in July. Deliveries for chemical purposes totalled 518 tons in August compared with 9,124 tons in July.

Imports of salt, including all grades, totalled 23,993 tons at \$116,636 in August and exports amounted to 279 tons valued at \$10,140.

Canadian salt production at the present time comes entirely from the provinces of Nova Scotia, Ontario, Manitoba and Alberta.
