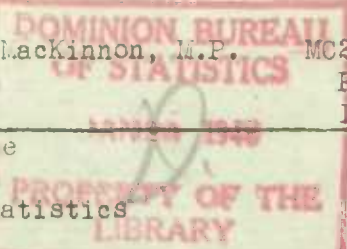

Monthly Report

S A L T

NOVEMBER, 1947

Production of common salt in Canada during November, 1947 totalled 65,509 tons, including 29,445 tons of table, common fine and other commercial grades, and 36,064 tons for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for October, 1947 was 64,928 tons.

Shipments of commercial grades in November totalled 28,497 tons compared with 29,749 tons in October. Deliveries for chemical purposes totalled 36,347 tons in November compared with 32,955 tons in the previous month.

Imports of salt, including all grades, in November totalled 15,468 tons valued at \$86,672, and exports amounted to 1,324 tons valued at \$40,676.
