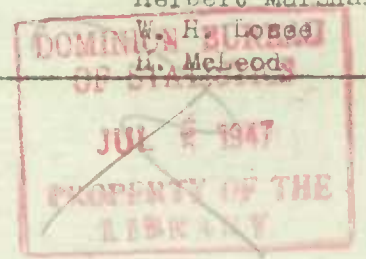

Monthly Report

SALT

April, 1947

Production of common salt in Canada during April, 1947, totalled 81,603 short tons, including 45,512 tons of table, common fine and other commercial grades, and 36,091 tons for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for March, 1947, was 77,616 tons.

Shipments of commercial grades in April totalled 43,919 tons compared with 37,335 tons in March. Deliveries for chemical purposes totalled 35,741 tons in April compared with 35,749 tons in the previous month.

Imports of salt, including all grades, totalled 10,261 tons valued at \$64,599, and exports amounted to 122 tons valued at \$3,550.
