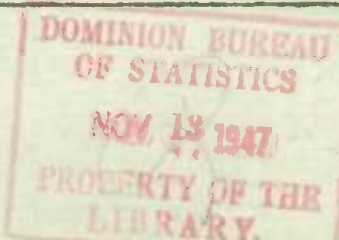

AUGUST, 1947



Production of common salt in Canada during August, 1947 totalled 61,642 short tons, including 26,298 tons of table, common fine and other commercial grades, and 35,344 tons for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for July, 1947 was 67,688 tons.

Shipments of commercial grades in August, totalled 28,576 tons compared with 32,791 tons in July. Deliveries for chemical purposes totalled 35,563 tons in August compared with 34,036 tons in the previous month.

Imports of salt including all grades, in August, totalled 22,650 tons valued at \$140,966, and exports amounted to 2,683 tons valued at \$51,001.
