

Monthly ReportS A L TSEPTEMBER, 1947

Production of common salt in Canada during September, 1947 totalled 55,931 short tons, including 25,697 tons of table, common fine and other commercial grades, and 30,234 tons for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for August, 1947 was 61,642 tons.

Shipments of commercial grades in September, totalled 27,301 tons compared with 24,576 tons in August. Deliveries for chemical purposes totalled 30,222 tons in September compared with 35,563 tons in the previous month.

Imports of salt, including all grades, in September, totalled 37,528 tons valued at \$193,246 and exports amounted to 1,324 tons valued at \$14,128.
