## MARCH, 1948

Production of common salt in Canada, in March, 1948, totalled 56,284 tons, including 27,525 tons of dry salt and 28,759 tons in brine for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for February was 56,756 tons.

Shipments of dry salt in March, 1948 totalled 25,674 tons compared with 26,755 tons in February. Deliveries of brine for chemical purposes totalled 28,759 tons in March compared with 27,328 tons in the previous month.

Imports of salt, including all grades, in March totalled 8,436 tons valued at \$58,962 and exports amounted to 315 tons valued at \$8,006.
