JUNE, 1948

Production of common salt in Canada in June, 1948, totalled 66,673 tons, including 38,961 tons of dry salt and 27,146 tons in brine for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for May was 58,375 tons.

Shipments of dry salt in June, 1948 totalled 37,475 tons compared with 33,463 tons in May. Deliveries of brine for chemical purposes totalled 27,146 tons in June compared with 28,370 tons in the previous month.

Imports of salt, including all grades, in June totalled 20,622 tons valued at \$110,152 and exports amounted to 563 tons valued at \$8,571.
