## SALT

## JULY, 1948

Froduction of common salt in Canada in July, 1948 totalled 64,765 tons, including 36,909 tons of dry salt and 27,856 tons in brine for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for June was 66.673 tons.

Shipments of dry salt in July, 1948 totalled 40,869 tons compared with 37,475 tons in June. Deliveries of brine for chemical purposes totalled 27,856 tons in July compared with 27,146 tons in the previous month. Exports amounted to 485 tons valued at \$10,879, figures on imports for this month are not yet available.
