SALT

AUGUST - 1948

Production of common salt in Canada in August, 1948, totalled 61,937 tons, including 32,816 tons of dry salt and 29,121 tons in brine for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for July was 64,765 tons.

Shipments of dry salt in August, 1948, totalled 37,045 tons compared with 40,869 tons in July. Deliveries of brine for chemical purposes totalled 29,121 tons in August, compared with 27,856 tons in the previous month.

Imports of salt, including all grades, in July totalled 14,794 tons valued at \$81,462 while August figures were 25,261 tons valued at \$149,276. Exports for August, amounted to 388 tons valued at \$11,243.
