JANUARY, 1949

Production of common salt in Canada in January, 1949 totalled 60,959 tons, including 27,714 tons of dry salt and 33,245 tons in brine for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output of salt for December, 1948 was 62,649 tons.

Shipments of dry salt in January, 1949 totalled 27,796 tons compared with 29,564 tons in December, 1948. Deliveries of brine for chemical purposes totalled 33,245 tons in January, compared with 34,224 tons in December, 1948.
