OCTOBER - 1949

Production of common salt in Canada in October, 1949 totalled 68,709 tons, including 40,790 tons of dry salt and 27,919 tons of brine for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for September was 71,229 tons.

Shipments of dry salt in October, 1949 totalled 41,054 tons compared with 41,556 tons in the previous month. Deliveries of brine for chemical purposes totalled 27,919 tons in October compared with 30,998 tons in September.
