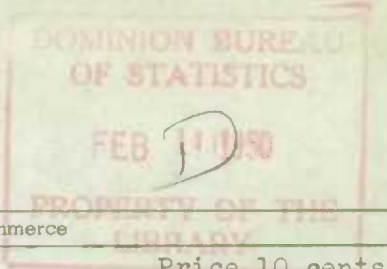

November - 1949

Production of common salt in Canada in November, 1949 totalled 71,895 tons, including 43,924 tons of dry salt and 27,971 tons of brine for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for October was 68,709 tons.

Shipments of dry salt in November, 1949 totalled 42,152 tons compared with 41,054 tons in the previous month. Deliveries of brine for chemical purposes totalled 27,971 tons in November compared with 27,919 tons in October.
