DECEMBER - 1949

Production of common salt in Canada in December, 1949 totalled 61,409 tons, including 33,310 tons of dry salt and 28,099 tons of brine for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for November was 71,895 tons.

Shipments of dry salt in December, 1949 totalled 32,899 tons compared with 42,152 tons in the previous month. Deliveries of brine for chemical purposes totalled 28,099 tons in December compared with 27,971 tons in November.
