## APRIL - 1949

Production of common salt in Canada in April, 1949 totalled 57,292 tons including 31,478 tons of dry salt and 25,814 tons in brine for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for March was 53,750 tons.

Shipments of dry salt in April, 1949 totalled 27,584 tons compared with 24,975 tons in the previous month. Deliveries of brine for chemical purposes totalled 25,814 tons in April, compared with 25,819 tons in March.
