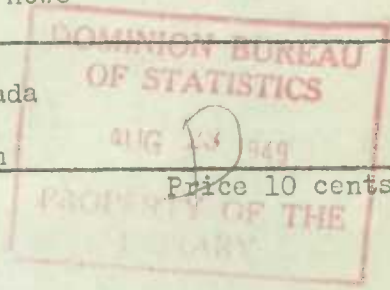

JUNE - 1949

Production of common salt in Canada in June, 1949 totalled 64,118 tons, including 34,515 tons of dry salt and 29,603 tons in brine for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for May was 57,179 tons.

Shipments of dry salt in June, 1949 totalled 36,380 tons compared with 32,982 tons in the previous month. Deliveries of brine for chemical purposes totalled 29,603 tons in June, compared with 27,448 tons in May.
