JULY - 1949

Production of common salt in Canada in July, 1949 totalled 62,169 tons, including 30,983 tons of dry salt and 31,186 tons in brine for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for June was 64,118 tons.

Shipments of dry salt in July, 1949 totalled 33,947 tons compared with 36,380 tons in the previous month. Deliveries of brine for chemical purposes totalled 31,186 tons in July compared with 29,603 tons in June.
