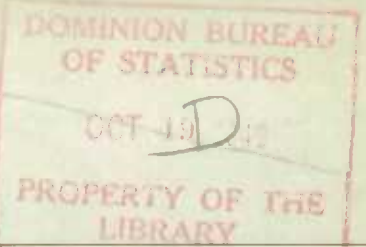

S A L TAUGUST - 1949

Production of common salt in Canada in August, 1949 totalled 64,092 tons, including 32,178 tons of dry salt and 31,914 tons in brine for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for July was 62,169 tons.

Shipments of dry salt in August, 1949 totalled 32,746 tons compared with 33,947 tons in the previous month. Deliveries of brine for chemical purposes totalled 31,914 tons in August compared with 31,186 tons in July.
