## SALT

## SEPTEMBER - 1949

Production of common salt in Canada in September, 1949 totalled 71,229 tons, including 40,231 tons of dry salt and 30,998 tons in brine for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for August was 64,092 tons.

Shipments of dry salt in September, 1949 totalled 41,556 tons compared with 32,746 tons in the previous month. Deliveries of brine for chemical purposes totalled 30,998 tons in September compared with 31,914 tons in August.
