SALT

OCTOBER - 1950

Production of common salt in Canada in October 1950 totalled 73,689 tons, including 42,943 tons of dry salt and 30,746 tons of brine for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for September was 77,844 tons.

Shipments of dry salt in October 1950 totalled 46,519 tons compared with 46,253 tons in the previous month. Deliveries of brine for chemical purposes totalled 30,746 tons in October compared with 30,709 tons in September.
