SALT

NOVEMBER - 1950

Production of common salt in Canada in November, 1950 totalled 81,052 tons, including 49,927 tons of dry salt and 31,125 tons of brine for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for October was 73,689 tons.

Shipments of dry salt in November, 1950 totalled 48,599 tons compared with 46,519 tons in the previous month. Deliveries of brine for chemical purposes totalled 31,125 tons in November compared with 30,746 tons in October.
