

SALT

DECEMBER - 1950

Production of common salt in Canada in December, 1950 totalled 71,323 tons, including 38,015 tons of dry salt and 33,308 tons of brine for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for November was 81,052 tons.

Shipments of dry salt in December, 1950 totalled 39,002 tons compared with 48,599 tons in the previous month. Deliveries of brine for chemical purposes totalled 33,308 tons in December compared with 31,125 tons in November.
