MARCH -- 1950

Production of common salt in Canada in March, 1950 totalled 62,158 tons, including 34,355 tons of dry salt and 27,803 tons of brine for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for February was 58,759 tons.

Shipments of dry salt in March, 1950 totalled 34,079 tons compared with 32,820 tons in the previous month. Deliveries of brine for chemical purposes totalled 27,803 tons in March, compared with 25,206 tons in February.
