SALT

JUNE - 1950

Production of common salt in Canada in June, 1950 totalled 67,032 tons, including 38,533 tons of dry salt and 28,499 tons of brine for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for May was 70,865 tons.

Shipments of dry salt in June, 1950 totalled 43,955 tons compared with 36,116 tons in the previous month. Deliveries of brine for chemical purposes totalled 28,499 tons in June compared with 29,479 tons in May.
