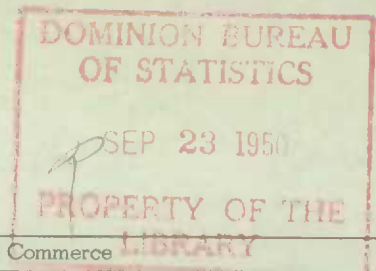

JULY - 1950

Production of common salt in Canada in July, 1950 totalled 59,938 tons, including 31,754 tons of dry salt and 28,184 tons of brine for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for June was 67,032 tons.

Shipments of dry salt in July, 1950 totalled 33,694 tons compared with 43,955 tons in the previous month. Deliveries of brine for chemical purposes totalled 28,184 tons in July compared with 28,499 tons in June.
