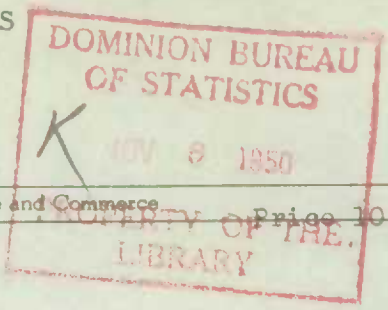

AUGUST - 1950

Production of common salt in Canada in August, 1950 totalled 62,049 tons, including 35,507 tons of dry salt and 26,542 tons of brine for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for July was 59,938 tons.

Shipments of dry salt in August, 1950 totalled 35,551 tons compared with 33,694 tons in the previous month. Deliveries of brine for chemical purposes totalled 26,542 tons in August compared with 28,184 tons in July.
