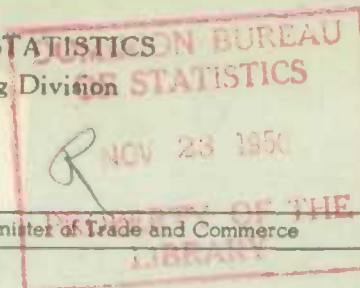

September - 1950

Production of common salt in Canada in September 1950 totalled 77,844 tons, including 47,135 tons of dry salt and 30,709 tons of brine for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for August was 62,049 tons.

Shipments of dry salt in September 1950 totalled 46,253 tons compared with 35,551 tons in the previous month. Deliveries of brine for chemical purposes totalled 30,709 tons in September compared with 26,542 tons in August.
