Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 49,279 tons in October compared with 44,209 tons in September. For the first ten months of this year the shipments totalled 425,383 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 40,842 tons in October and 420,471 tons for the first ten months of the year.
