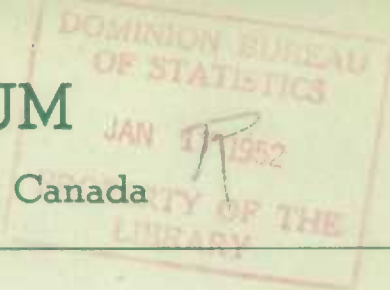

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 58,524 tons in November compared with 49,279 tons in October. The year to date shipments totalled 483,907 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 40,739 tons in November and 461,210 tons for the year to date, 1951.
