Production of common salt in Canada in April, 1951 totalled 69,069 tons, including 38,611 tons of dry salt and 30,458 tons of brine for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for March, 1951 was 71,918 tons.

Shipments of dry salt in April, 1951 totalled 35,939 tons compared with 35,608 tons in the previous month. Deliveries of brine for chemical purposes totalled 30,458 tons in April compared with 33,333 tons in March, 1951.
