SALT MAY - 1951

Production of common salt in Canada in May, 1951 totalled 71,953 tons, including 38,637 tons of dry salt and 33,316 tons of brine for the manufacture of chemicals. The total output for April, 1951 was 69,069 tons.

Shipments of dry salt in May, 1951 totalled 41,444 tons compared with 35,939 tons in the previous month. Deliveries of brine for chemical purposes totalled 33,316 tons in May compared with 30,458 tons in April, 1951.
