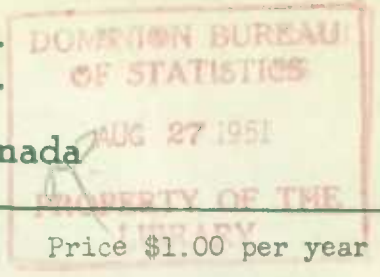

JUNE - 1951

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 44,149 tons in June compared with 41,444 tons in May. For the first six months of this year the shipments totalled 234,510 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 65,313 tons in June, and 408,292 tons for the first half of the year.
