## JULY - 1951

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 51,125 tons in July compared with 44,149 tons in June. For the first seven months of this year the shipments totalled 551,955 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 45,405 tons in July and 301,505 tons for the first seven months of the year.
