Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 44,209 tons in September compared with 46,260 tons in August. For the first nine months of this year the shipments totalled 376,104 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 40,488 tons in September and 379,629 tons for the first nine months of the year.
