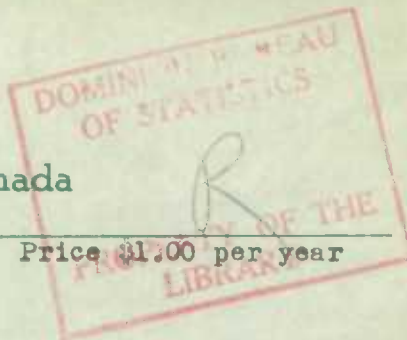

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 59,388 tons in October, compared with 45,067 tons in the previous month. The October, 1951 shipments totalled 49,279 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 39,701 tons in October, 1952 and 38,142 tons for the month of October, 1951.
